### ○ Vote Rex Rhino for President



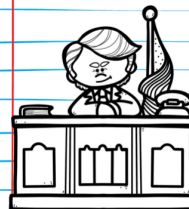
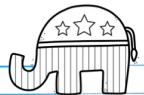
Vote for me!

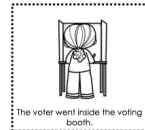
