ACROSTIC POEM MINI-LESSON

CONNECT

Connect to what you've been learning or reading about in regards to Thanksgiving. Boys and girls we've been reading about Thanksgiving and have learned quite a few things. Today we are going to write a special kind of poem called an Acrostic poem to show what we know about _____.

TEACH

An acrostic poem uses the letters in a word to begin each line of the poem. All lines of the poem relate to or describe the main topic. Acrostic poems could be written with just one word, a phrase or a sentence.

Model for the class how you would write an acrostic poem. Use the poem provided.

WINTER

ENGAGE

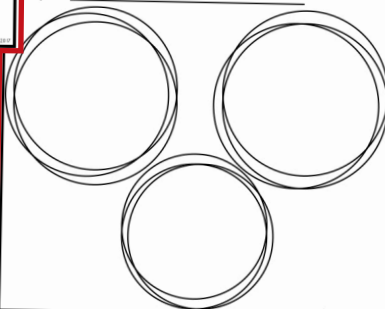
